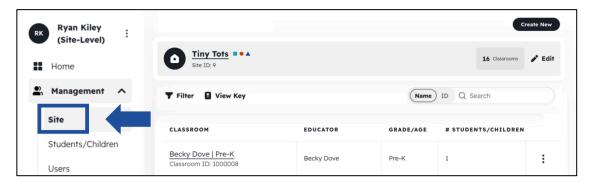

Steps for Single-Site Administrators, including Family Day Home Providers:

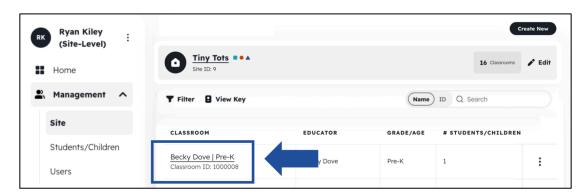
First, access the Classroom Profile. You can access and edit your Classroom Profile two different ways: through Management or through your VQB5 Registration page.

Access your Classroom Profiles via Management

- 1. Select "Management" from the left-hand navigation.
- 2. Select "Site" to view your list of Classrooms.



3. From the list of Classrooms, select the **Classroom** you would like to edit.







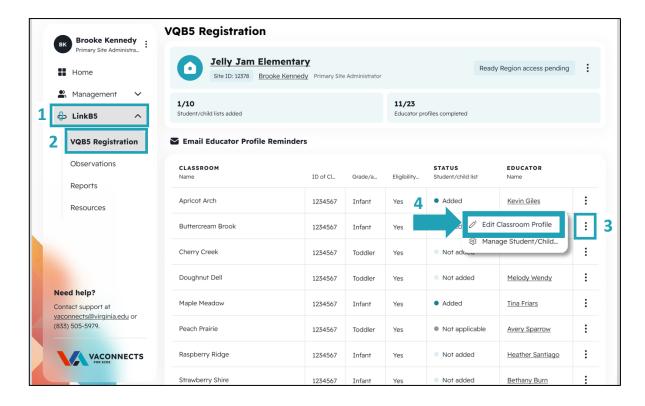


4. From the Classroom's page, click on "Edit."



Or, access your Classroom Profiles via the VQB5 Registration page

- 1. Select "LinkB5."
- 2. Select "VQB5 Registration."
- 3. Select the Menu next to the Classroom.
- 4. Select "Edit Classroom Profile."



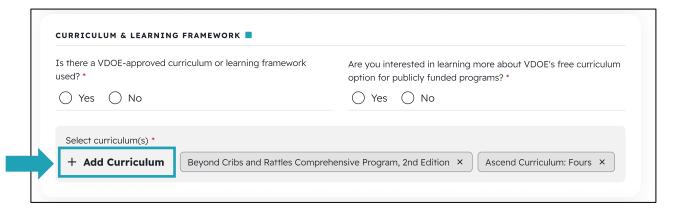




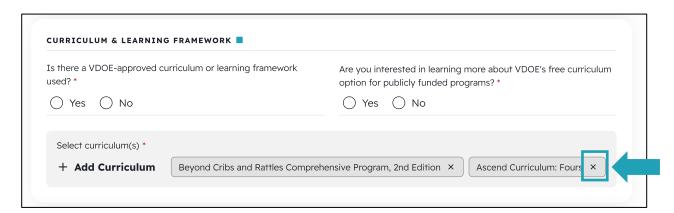
Then, edit the Classroom Profile to add the VDOE-Approved Curriculum

4. From the list of Classrooms, select the **Classroom** you would like to edit.



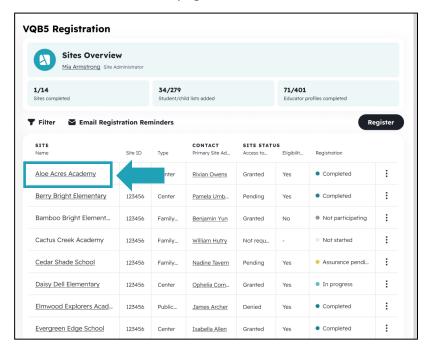




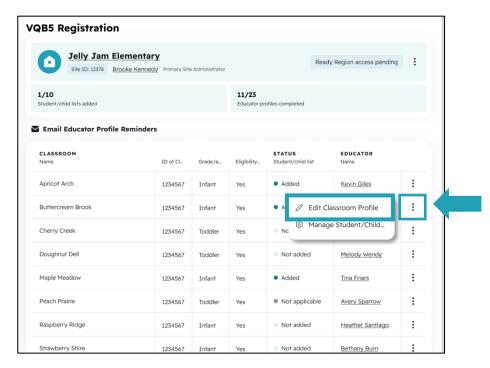


Or, access your Classroom Profiles via the VQB5 Registration page

- 3. Select "Edit Classroom Profile."





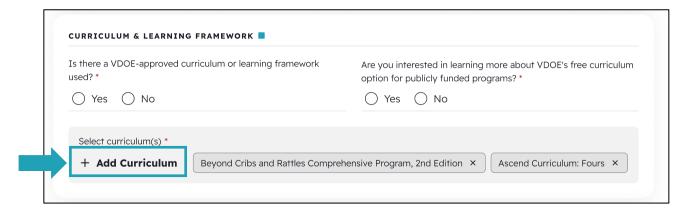






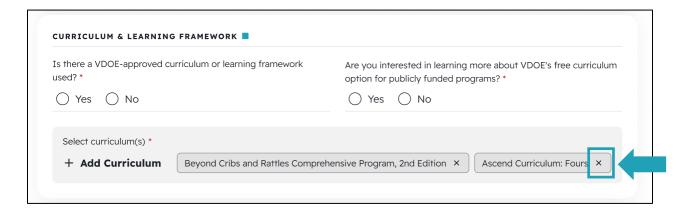
Then, edit the Classroom Profile to add the VDOE-Approved Curriculum
